My name is Adam Bassuk, and my family and I have been residents of Manhattan Beach for over twenty years. Suffice it to say, I love this city. My reason for writing to you today is because I believe that there is an opportunity to make healthcare in Manhattan Beach even more accessible for our community. Last year, I had a health condition that could not be readily treated by my primary doctor, and I was fortunate enough to receive life saving treatment from the team at Sollis Health. Sollis functions as an extension of one's primary care doctor, for both care during hours when your primary care clinic is not open, and – as was my case – for conditions not within a primary doctor's scope.
