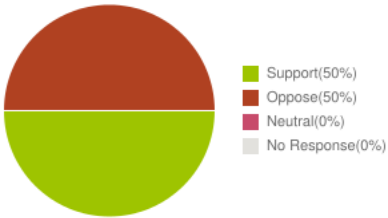

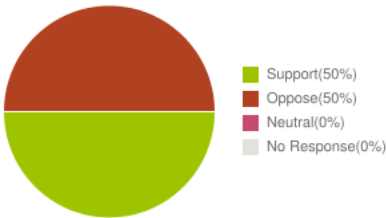

Overall Sentiment



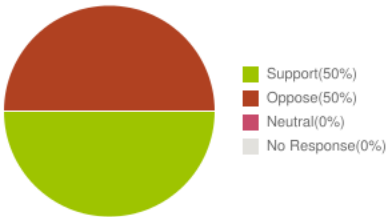
