Dogs 4 months or older residing in the City for more than 30 days are required to be licensed. (M.B.M.C. 5.01.140).

Sterile Animal (with proof):	<b>\$23</b>
Intact Animal:	<b>\$51</b>
Replacement Tag:	<b>\$4</b>

**RENEWALS DUE BY SEPTEMBER 30, 2024**

## RABIES VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS:

**Current Rabies Vaccination Certificate is required in order for a license to be issued.**

- Vaccination status or invoice will not be accepted
- Certificate must include lot/serial number of vaccine

**MUST NOT EXPIRE BEFORE 8/31/2025\***

\*Except for initial 1-year immunizations.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING VACCINATION EXEMPTIONS:

Effective Jan 1, 2012, due to changes in the State and County rabies laws, exemption from rabies vaccination can only be granted by the County Veterinary Public Health Department. More information and Application for Exemption available at your local Veterinarian office.
