Dear Manhattan Beach Property Owner:

The City of Manhattan Beach City has scheduled an informational public meeting for property owners in District 8 to introduce the **assessment method of apportionment**. District 8 boundaries are generally described as encompassing 8<sup>th</sup> Street to 15<sup>th</sup> Street from Manhattan Ave to The Strand.

The draft assessment methodology to be presented will identify the array of property uses, methodology options, the basis of assessment fitted for District 8 and the apportionment calculations. Homeowners will be presented with:

- 1) Overview of the District 8 schedule of events.
- 2) Presentation on the Assessment Methodology by the City's Assessment Engineer – *Harris and Associates* and;
- 3) Current 2009 estimated assessment ranges.

We encourage you to attend this undergrounding district community meeting. Representatives from the City, Harris & Associates and utility companies will be present to answer questions you may have. Discussion will be focused primarily on the assessment methodology.

Please note that District 8 has NOT been fully established. Pursuant to the requirements of California Proposition 218, the assessment district will not legally form unless more than 50% of the weighted return ballots from district property owners are in favor of the assessment and the City Council ratifies the district vote. A ballot vote count will take place once the value to be assessed to each parcel has been determined by the Assessment Engineer and noticed to property owners (in the near future).
