REUSE: Be creative and repurpose!

~ Shred used wrapping paper from years past or any other paper lying around to use as filler instead of tissue paper or as packing material. Wrap an old shoe box with a brown paper bag, decorate and fill with shredded paper. Now you've got a beautiful, sustainable gift!

RECYCLE: Keep materials out of the landfill

- ~ Buy recycled to increase the demand for recycled products.
- ~ Place clean plastic, paper, glass and metal in your blue bin!

......... Waste & Recycling Collection: Easy as 1,2,3

- Trash goes in your GRAY cart, or can.
- Recycling goes in your BLUE cart or can, including all plastics labeled #1-#7, clean plastic grocery bags, Styrofoam, glass food and beverage containers, and all clean paper.
- Green waste goes into your GREEN cart or can, including grass, leaves, wood chips, & tree limbs. NO palm fronds, cactus or yucca, dirt, rocks, bags, or pet waste are allowed in the green waste cart!
