- b. Water Conservation and Sustainable Landscaping: To assist the City in its efforts to protect our water supply, the Water Conservation Work Group will develop the following for ETF and Council approval: (1) Targeted outreach programs (students, residents, business) to educate the public on the current water supply situation and economically feasible solutions to help conserve water; (2) Turf-removal outreach/incentive program for the community, creating a municipal sustainable landscaping goal as the lead; and (3) Promotion of existing (and new) partnerships that will provide resources and incentives to the community to encourage water conservation through sustainable landscaping.
