Subject: Pacific Avenue Street Resurfacing Project

Dear Manhattan Beach Resident/Business Owner:


Included in the City's 2010–2011 Capital Improvement Program is the street resurfacing at the following locations:

- Pacific Avenue: Manhattan Beach Boulevard to Ardmore Avenue
- Pacific Avenue: Valley Drive to Rosecrans Avenue

The purpose of the project is to improve the condition of the pavement areas, provide a neat appearing, smooth riding surface, enhance the overall appearance of the street, and allow for better control of nuisance and storm water. The project will upgrade the service level, reduce maintenance and stem further deterioration along the improved segments of road. Proposed construction will be primarily oriented toward cold milling of the existing asphalt roadway surface and construction of a new asphalt overlay. The project also includes full depth roadway reconstruction of significantly deteriorated areas and some minor concrete reconstruction.

It is estimated that the Contractor, All American Asphalt, will commence construction by July 05, 2011 and complete the work in 35 working days. During the construction period a City representative will be on the job site to provide assistance to residents and coordinate the work. If necessary, parking prohibitions will be posted 72 hours prior to street closure. Provisions in the contract require that the Contractor maintain access to residences in the work area, however, access along portions of the street may be necessarily limited due to adjacent roadway reconstruction. The Contractor will be permitted to work from 7:30am to 5:00pm on weekdays in order to assure completion of the project on time. The Contractor will submit a more detailed schedule upon commencing construction and residents within the affected construction areas will be notified as the work schedule progresses.
