2011-2012 SEWER MAIN REHABILITATION PROJECT, PHASE 1

******* FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS *******

Q: What type of project is this and what is the purpose of the project?

A: This project is a sanitary sewer main replacement. A new sewer main will be constructed along a trench line in the paved roadway or walkway. The purpose of this project will be to replace and abandon the existing deteriorated sewer line, reconnect existing house service laterals and restore the roadway and/or walkway improvements. The City has awarded the contract to a general engineering contractor to construct the project.

Q: Where will this project take place?

A: Project construction will take place on the following streets:

1. **Alma Avenue:** from 24th Street to 27th Street
2. **Marine Avenue:** from Highland Ave to Grandview Ave
3. **24th Street:** from The Strand to Highland Ave

Q: When will this project begin and what is the project schedule?

A: This project will begin at the end of April 2012 and will end in September 2012. Each project street will take approximately 6-weeks to complete. Working hours are from 7:30am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday.

Q: How will traffic be affected?

A: Traffic delays are expected and it is recommended that alternate routes be used to avoid the construction area. The contractor will implement traffic control measures accordingly. Provisions in the contract require that the contractor maintain access to residences in the immediate work area; however, access to some driveways may be temporarily limited due to adjacent work.
